Red cards, late winners and penalty shoot-outs dominated the midweek games. Wodson Park saw their unbeaten league record ended and Hadley produced the only midweek giant-killing act. Following managerial departures recently both Leighton Town and Totternhoe have announced new appointments. Premier Division Leighton Town have turned to former London Colney pair Joe Sweeney and Paul Copson while Division Two side Totternhoe have appointed ex Dunstable Town boss Darren Croft.

HERTS SENIOR CHALLENGE CUP First Round

Hadley produced the best result in the First Round of the Herts Senior Challenge Cup when defeating Bostik League South Central Division side Ware 1-0. A stoppage time winner by Chris Blunden saw Leverstock Green overcome fellow SSML side Oxhey Jets 2-1 at Pancake Lane to set up a trip to Watford in Round Two. Elsewhere both Harpenden Town and London Colney suffered 0-3 home defeats again ex-SSML sides, the 'Harps' losing to St Margaretsbury while Colney lost out to last season's SSML Premier Division runners-up Berkhamsted.

In the only midweek league action Potton United edged out London Tigers by the odd goal in three at the Hutchinson Hollow to move up to fourth place. The win means Potton United have now won their last three league games while for Tigers it was their third successive league defeat.

DIVISION ONE

Wodson Park suffered their first league defeat when going down to the odd goal in three at Enfield Borough, the win takes Borough to second place in the table. Winslow United made it seven games without defeat with a 5-2 home win over Amersham Town in front of 88 spectators with Ryan Freshwater grabbing a hat-trick which included two from the penalty spot. Langford came from a goal down to win 3-1 at neighbouring Ampthill Town. On Wednesday night Park View's trip to London Lions saw them squeeze past the hosts with an odd goal in three win.

THE BUILDABASE FA VASE First Round Proper Replays

Both Buckingham Athletic and Colney Heath failed to add to the SSML six representatives in the Second Round of the Buildabase FA Vase. Buckingham Athletic's long midweek trip to the coast saw them race into a two goal lead before being pegged back shortly after the interval. Hosts FC Clacton then snatched victory with a last minute winner. Colney Heath found themselves 0-2 down at Histon after 26 minutes and their task was not made any easier when three players saw red (35 mins, 65 mins and 81 mins) in a bad tempered game.

AND FINALLY

When you know your star striker is having a bad day at the office. A football belonging to a British church team has been found across the North Sea on the beach of a small island off the coast of Germany. Josh Holebon, manager of Stalham Baptist Church FC, in Norfolk, said it was a mystery how it got there. He received an unexpected email last month from Thomas Selinger, who lives in Freiburg and found the ball when visiting Baltrum Island. The ball was marked "Stalham Baptist" and he made contact online. Typical. You wait 22 games for a competitive victory and then two come along in the space of four days. Having broken their duck in Armenia on Saturday, Gibraltar claimed a second competitive win by coming from behind to beat Liechtenstein in the Nations League. It is the first time the side, ranked 198th in the world, have scored more than once in any game. The result even gives them hope of gualifying for Euro 2020 through the Nations League - they are three points behind leaders Macedonia in Group D4. Gibraltar became a UEFA-affiliated team in 2013 and prior to Saturday's result their only two wins - against Malta and Latvia - had come in friendly matches. They lost all of their Euro 2016 and 2018 World Cup qualifying matches, conceding 56 in the former and 47 in the latter.

Baldock Town is a North Hertfordshire-based Football Club and currently has two senior teams.

The 1st Team play in the Spartan South Midlands League Premier Division which is at the ninth-tier of the National League System (Step 5 in the Non-League Pyramid).

The club's Development Team play in the Herts Senior County League Division One, which is two levels below the 1st Team.

We were formed in 2003 after Southern League Baldock Town FC folded back in 2001. The new senior side, which was simply named Baldock FC, was formed from former products of the youth system and was put together by committee members of the successful youth setup (www.baldocktyfc.co.uk).

Although the club has gone on to bring in players from other surrounding areas, it has always been one of the main policies of the committee to provide football for players from Baldock, particularly youngsters of the Youth FC when their playing days came to an end.
