FACING US TODAY - COLNEY HEATH FC

The club was established in 1907 and initially played in the Hatfield District League. After World War I they joined the Mid-Herts League, and their most successful period in the league came after World War II, with the club winning the Division One and Premier Division titles, as well as the Mid Herts Benevolent Shield (twice) and the Bingham Cox Cup.

In 1953 the club moved up to Division Two of the Hertfordshire Senior County League, which they won at the first attempt to earn promotion to Division One. In 1955 the club were placed in Division One A as the league was reorganised; they went on to win the division in 1955–56 and were placed in the new Premier Division for the following season.

In 1958–59 they were Premier Division champions, and the following season saw them win both the Aubrey Cup and the Hertfordshire Intermediate Cup. In 1965–66 Colney Heath finished second-from-bottom of the Premier Division and were relegated back to Division One. They were relegated again at the end of the 1968–69 season, returning to Division Two. Another relegation in 1975–76 saw them playing in Division Three.

However, after finishing as runners-up in 1979–80 the club were promoted back to Division Two. A fourth-place finish in 1983–84 was enough to see them promoted to Division One, and after finishing third in Division One in 1985–86, they returned to the Premier Division. Their first season back in the Premier Division ended in relegation to Division One, but the club were Division One champions in 1988–89, earning promotion back to the Premier Division. In 1995–96 they won the Hertfordshire Senior Centenary Trophy, which they retained the following season.

The 1999–2000 season saw Colney Heath win the Premier Division of the Hertfordshire Senior County League, resulting in promotion to the Senior Division of the Spartan South Midlands League, which was renamed Division One in 2001. They were Division One champions in 2005–06, earning promotion to the Premier Division. In 2010–11 the club won the Premier Division Cup. They won the Hertfordshire Charity Shield in 2013–14, and again in 2017–18.

PREMIER DIVISION

More late drama in the battle for the Premier Division title, morning leaders Biggleswade FC were rocked as a last gasp equalizer from visitors Wembley saw them surrender top spot. Tring Athletic returned to the summit with a 4-2 success at Edgware Town. Hadley are now third after a 1-1 draw at Leighton Town while fourth placed Biggleswade United defeated Oxhey Jets 4-1 on the road. If the battle at the top is tight then likewise the relegation battle, Stotfold moved out of the bottom two with a 3-0 home success against London Colney. Replacing them are London Tigers who were beaten 1-2 at Baldock Town while Cockfosters remain bottom despite drawing 1-1 at Colney Heath in what turned out to be an incident packed battle with no less than five red cards. Elsewhere North Greenford United FC suffered a 0-3 home defeat at the hands of Arlesey Town. Harpenden Town went down to the odd goal in five at Potton United while Crawley Green achieved their first clean sheet since September when they out gunned visiting Leverstock Green 5-0.

DIVISION ONE

Harefield United continue to march on towards an unbeaten league season with a 3-1 win at FC Broxbourne Borough, the Hares are now just three games away from achieving their goal and need another 7 points to break Berkhamsted's 107 points record set back in 2010/11. Tenants Broadfields United (assured of runners-up) won 4-2 at home against Langford to maintain their promotion hopes as one of the best clubs finishing second determined by Points Per Game. Winslow United assured themselves of third place when defeating relegation haunted Codicote 4-0. Both Brimsdown and Amersham Town picked up a useful away point in their bid to escape the drop, Brimsdown drawing 2-2 at Enfield Borough while Amersham's game at relegated Hatfield Town finished goalless. Buckingham Athletic, now fourth, drew 4-4 at Park View thanks to a late equalizer. Ampthill Town swept aside Rayners Lane with a four goal first half blitz. Bedford went down 0-2 at Hillingdon Borough while Risborough Rangers won 6-0 in convincing style at Wodson Park. The day's other fixture also saw plenty of goals as sixth placed London Lions won 4-2 at home against Milton Keynes Robins.

DIVISION TWO

Bovingdon, in their first season in the Spartan South Midlands League, lifted the championship with a 4-0 win at Unite MK although with no floodlights it is likely that promotion will elude them. The chase for the runners-up spot continues as second placed Berkhamsted Raiders picked up a point with a 2-2 draw at Mursley United. Third placed Old Bradwell United won 4-1 in their 'derby' game at MK Gallacticos while fourth placed Aston Clinton's faint hopes saw them winning 7-0 at bottom club Clean Slate.
